Most of you reading this are academics, so in order to save space, I'm just going to jump into the science of it and assume that you'll understand and/or Google what you're not familiar with.

When Arizona cotton farmer David Hudson announced to the United States Patent Office that he wanted to put a patent on gold, you can imagine the raised eyebrows: "David, everyone knows about gold, you can't patent it."

"Not like this they don't!" He replied with a grin. In the mid 1970s, while mining for gold on his farm, this deeply conservative man came across some strange materials that didn't fit inside any chemical/mineral box that he knew of. Several million dollars worth of analysis and a decade later, Hudson was granted patents on the exotic materials, which he called Orbitally Rearranged Monatomic Elements or ORMEs and the methods for obtaining them.

For convenience, let's refer to them as elements in their m-state or ORMUS form since we are not certain that they are "monatomic" or "orbitally rearranged". A monatomic element has one atom per molecule, a diatomic element has two atoms per molecule. It appears that certain elements in a monatomic or diatomic

configuration can form a stable structure where all of their electrons are Cooper-paired¹ and so are not available as valence electrons [= outermost electrons that determine how an atom will react with other atoms]. Elements in this configuration exhibit some properties of superconductors at room temperature and exhibit other quantum physical behaviours at a visible scale. Some of these behaviours include: (1) Anomalous responses to gravity; (2) Superfluidity; (3)

Physicists have recently created a new state of matter in the laboratory. This state of matter is called a Bose-Einstein Condensate (BEC) after Satyendra Nath Bose and Albert Einstein, who postulated the existence of this state of matter in the 1920s. Their theory wasn't proved until BECs were created in the laboratory in 1995 by Eric Cornell and Carl Weismann in Boulder, Colorado. They did it by cooling atoms to a much lower temperature than had previously been achieved. This temperature was a millionth of a degree above absolute zero.

Absolute zero is the temperature at which all atomic movement ceases. When atoms are cooled near absolute zero, they move much more slowly than when they are at normal temperatures.

David Hudson postulates that his ORME atoms have a natural internal temperature, which is very close to absolute zero. This may be why they might possibly be Bose-Einstein condensates *at room temperature and higher*.

A Bose-Einstein Condensate is a group of atoms, which are all in the same quantum state. Such a group of atoms consequently behaves, in some ways, as a single atom. Superconductors are a form of BEC and so are superfluids.

BECs are known to have the

"Tunnelling" through solid objects; and (4) Repulsion by magnetic fields (Barry Carter).²

So naturally, you're thinking, Well, which elements? And what's so special about them? These are the culprits: Cobalt, Nickel, Copper, Ruthenium, Rhodium, Palladium, Silver, Osmium, Iridium, Platinum, Gold, and Mercury. These elements appear to be more abundant in nature in the m-state than in their metallic form. They're exceptional because according to David Hudson's discoveries, these elements in their m-state may be as much as 10,000 times more abundant than their metallic counterparts. There appear to be other elements, which occur naturally in the m-state.

At My Desk

Penrose and Hameroff may be known to some readers for their theory about consciousness originating in so-called *microtubules*, which constitute the deeper structure of brain neurons. The theory involves quantum behaviour in the brain (see McCloghry-Bartley's feature article). I came across Hameroff and Penrose's theory while co-editing the book *The Survival of Human Consciousness* with Dr. Michael Thalbourne back in 2004. I've always been intrigued by the idea that consciousness could survive, but there are many issues not usually considered about survival. What does one do in the afterlife? What does eternity entail? Would a discarnate entity ask such questions about the afterlife? Would it be able to ask questions at all? It's fine that scientists seem more concerned with establishing whether the survival of human consciousness is possible; but who answers questions concerned with the more pragmatic 'human' issues? Theologians? Sociologists? Survival might be too frightening for some people. And if consciousness is a product of microtubules and, therefore, the brain, and given that consciousness supposedly breaks free of its cellular (microtubular?) parameters, doesn't quantum consciousness sound like some kind of neodualism—maybe epiphenomenalism? Just when it looked like we were getting somewhere!

ability to "tunnel" across impenetrable barriers. Professor Brian D. Josephson of the Physics Department of the University of Cambridge received the Nobel Prize in Physics for his discovery of the tunnelling phenomenon. Josephson is currently working on something called the Mind-Matter Unification Project (Barry Carter).

Now, for me, this is where it gets really exciting. Josephson isn't the only scientist working out at the tip of the spear on revolutionary theories that unite matter and mind. It's been recently discovered, that in every cell, there exists a small structure called the microtubule. Incredibly, these structures exhibit superconductive and tunnelling behaviours at body temperature.

However, the quantum theory problem, is that there seems to be no way to link the Bose-Einstein Condensates, which require temperatures very close to absolute zero, with the BEC-like antics of microtubules at body temperature in living cells. ORMUS materials would make this connection!

Physicist Roger Penrose and anaesthesiologist Stuart Hameroff were both seeking a greater understanding of the incredible human mind. Penrose was searching for a more advanced way of explaining the amazing computational ability of the brain and Hameroff had been on the grail quest for the 'source of human consciousness'. As fate would have it, they heard of each other, met and realized they sought the same structure—the microtubule.

Microtubules reside within the neuron and are made of two forms of tubulin, which can be switched by tiny electric currents. Penrose theorized therefore that the microtubule units might be the on/off switches for the brain's data processing.

Here I'll quote ORMUS researcher Barry Carter quoting an anonymous scientist:

"I agree with this proposal because it allows us to be what we are by increasing our potential processing rate from an unacceptable 10^{11} operations per second to

a reasonably acceptable 10^{24} operations per second.

"Hameroff has done a lot of research into how consciousness works and he has concluded that the microtubules are the source of consciousness. This is discussed in and supported by Penrose's work. Hameroff has concluded that the observable quantum effects that occur in human brains are caused by highly aligned water that is inside the microtubules. Penrose agrees with this concept and further argues that Bose-Einstein Condensations (BECs) in the neurons are how we reach decisions. The BECs are possible because the water inside the microtubules can be strongly aligned to form a

high-temperature superconductive medium.

"This concept supports my thinking very well. BECs provide an explanation for all the effects I refer to as psionics. These effects include, telepathy, remote viewing, bilocation, telekinesis, and astral travel.

A BEC in the Broca area of the brain would allow thoughts to exist inside the brain and outside the head at the same time. They can explain both telepathy and how it is controlled. Like



wise a BEC in the visual processing areas would explain remote viewing. Since microtubules exist in all neurons and neurons extend into all parts of the body, a BEC including all neurons would allow the body to exist in two (or more) places at the same time, thus explaining bilocation.

"With this discovery, all

psionics can be explained in modern physical terms. This opens the whole field of psionics to persons like myself who have had so much technical training that it is impossible to accept psionics. This discovery means that all the formal training I had in Chemistry, Math and Physics still applies and can even help explain psionics. For me, it is good to know that all these topics can exist peacefully together".³

Quantum behaviour allows for and explains some of the most perplexing mysteries of human existence. The ORMUS materials and their probable existence in all cells, open the way for a whole new understanding of psi phenomena. It appears that when ORMUS materials enter the body, they

recharge the batteries within the cells and go to work repairing our severely limited DNA. Among many other things, this leads to increased intelligence and hemispheric coherence resulting in greater psi abilities, such as; telepathy, clairvoyance, prophecy and extreme empathy.

They appear to be the connecting factor between spirit and matter because they are, in the body, a quantum coherent resonant antenna with the DNA, which picks up energy and information from the 'ether'; or as David Bohm called it; The Implicate Order.

Historically, many cultures imply knowledge and use of the ORMUS materials, in some cases, placing them above all other means of gaining spiritual ascendance and immortality.

The *Egyptian Book of Going Forth By Day*, asks the question, What is it? What is it?

"I am purified of all imperfections, what is it, I ascend like the golden hawk of Horus, what is it, I come by the Immortals without dying, what is it."

Further, in ancient Egypt, in the 3rd Degree Initiation Ceremony (Part II: Akhenaton's Mesage) it says:

"The torchbearer now approached the initiates indicating

them to sit. He took the first in the row to the centre of the chamber, instructing her to position in front of the sarcophagus. Then an acolyte carrying a lapis lazuli platter with a small alabaster vessel approached her. The vessel had carved in it a winged Aton Disk wrapping its wings around the body. In it was Ben, the mysterious "What Then Is It", a white powder dissolved in water. As a sacred act of communion, he handed her the vessel to drink.

The Hebrew word for What is it? is *Ma-Na* [manna]—the white substance, which sustained the Israelites on their journey through the desert. In the book of Exodus, it says that the goldsmith and maker of The Ark of the Covenant, Bezaleel was ordered by Moses to make The Bread of the Presence of God to be set out on a golden table before The Ark. Can someone tell me why Moses would tell a goldsmith to bake bread?

It also says in Exodus, that within The Ark, were the stones through which God spoke to Moses, and a pot of Manna. In old kingdom Egypt, the word for eyelashes was the word for bush. So for God to speak to Moses through a burning bush could easily mean that He communicated with him through the burning Third Eye Chakra, awakened (or set aflame) by the ORMUS 'bread'.

In an Ayurvedic text that supposedly dates from circa 2000 BC, it says that one can take mercury and divide and divide and divide it until it reaches its pure essence which is a white powder of mercury. The way one tests to see if it's ready for ingestion, is to heat it in the air and if it turns to gold, then it's ready to consume. The text says:

"At the very touch of a philosopher's stone the sharp iron sword is turned into gold and afterwards it does not cut, even

if it has the appearance of a sword. Even so, the ego of the Siddha-Jnani or the Jivanmukta, though it has the appearance of individuality and presents a physical body, cannot bind the Siddha again to rebirth, for it is transformed into Suddha-Sattva by the touch of the Supreme Wisdom of the Absolute.

The book of Revelation says:

"Blessed be the man who will overcome for he shall be given the hidden manna, the white stone of purest kind, upon which will be written a new name" (David Hudson).⁴

Can we take that to mean that ingesting these materials will literally make one anew? I tend to think so, as I have personally seen in myself—after only one course of ORMUS water—a visible age reversal of at least five years, and an increase in physical energy, wellbeing, vitality, mental clarity and telepathy, a persistent euphoria, more vivid dreaming (including more fre-

quent lucid dreaming), and a great increase in what I can only call extreme good fortune. Synchronicity also appears to have increased to a noticeable degree. I don't think it would be too far out of the park to surmise that ORMUS materials may well be a vital component in the next evolutionary step of the human species.⁵ Ψ

¹ A Cooper pair is the name given to electrons that are bound together at low temperatures; the energy of the pairing interaction is quite weak, and thermal energy can easily break the pairs up.

The Weird and the Wonderful by Hannah Jenkins

You wouldn't think it would take so long to finally come to fruition, but I am very happy to report that the long-thought about, long planned Inaugural AIPR Annual Lecture was finally held at Deakin University in the first week of August. If you saw the announcement, you might have been there. If you were there, I hope you enjoyed it. If you couldn't make it, or the plethora of posters advertising the event somehow passed you by, here's a run down of the event.

The lecture was jointly hosted by the AIPR and the School of Psychology, Deakin University (remarkable for the fact that the school actively supports psi research and allows for the study of psi within mainstream psychology at Honours and Post Graduate levels).

It was a dark and stormy night (no jokes) as we gathered in the foyer of the lecture hall. The campus, alas, suffers from the architectural blight common to suburban campuses in Australian cities, all big

brightly lit Besser block structures surrounded by straggly under-watered trees. However, the 30 or so people who turned up made up for the bleak weather and surrounds. As did the speaker.

Dr. Jürgen Keil, the famous psychologist from the University of Tasmania, was the presenter for the night. And he didn't disappoint.

Dr. Keil enthralled the audience with a run down of his life as a psi researcher—how he first got to know about psi as a fitter and turner brought in to the University of Tasmania to help produce a mechanical apparatus to help measure apparent PK, and how what he saw intrigued him and allowed him to realise that psi was potentially real and measurable. (Few people know this, and he didn't mention it in the lecture, but Dr. Keil was one of the few scientists to actually see Nina Kulagina actively produce PK effects in Russia.)

He then moved on to describe his more recent research

into apparent reincarnation cases. The accompanying pictures could easily have been from a travel catalogue—Turkey and Thailand featured.

But the stories that went along with them were straight out of a psi novel. Dr. Keil spoke of cases where children in remote villages with stories about people that were later verified to be correct. And an interesting rendition of the birthmark theory, namely that in some places where reincarnation is accepted in the belief systems people who have died prematurely are sometimes marked with ash so that when a child is born with similar marks they can tell who it is. His suggested explanation for these events is where the talk really became interesting.

Having ruled out normal explanations for the acquisition of the information, Dr. Keil theorised that telepathy might be a more likely explanation than reincarnation as such. He also speculated that the correlation between birthmarks on the children and the ash marks

could be explained by maternal imprinting in the womb. A theory that I'd not heard before.

Question time was extremely lively, indicating that people were genuinely interested in the topic. It was reassuring to think that the effort of organising the event had paid off and people were actively engaging with psi in a setting that allowed for reasonable, rational discussion of the current research in the field.
